We have pleasure in forwarding the *Annual* for 1948, and take this opportunity to thank you for your continued interest and support.

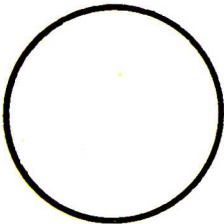
The Annual Subscription, two shillings and sixpence, is now due, and should be paid immediately to your Presbytery Correspondent, noted below.
