ALEXANDER SPRING ARCHIBALD MA
died June 1st 1992

Ordained 1929, inducted to Crawford 1951, retired 1972. He never lost his enthusiasm for the Biblical languages and Biblical studies. "For over 60 years he has faithfully ministered to other people in Morebattle, Turriff, Hownam, Wanganni, Crawford, Logie and even in the Nursing Home at Broomhall. For his vocation never died - he was always sharing the gifts of God with others."

JOHN JOHNSTON MBE MA BD JP
died August 6th 1993

Ordained 1932, he was appointed colleague and successor at St Peter's, Inverkeithing in 1937.

A traditional parish minister with a keen sense of humour, he served the Society well as Presbytery Correspondent for Dunfermline, and the wider Church through the General Trustees. Retired Dunfermline 1981.

JAMES P SHEPHERD Esq
died December 14th 1993

Following his appointment as Dominie of Biggar, he was active in the Society for the 21 years of his retirement in Edinburgh. Rarely missing a meeting, he served on the Council with modesty, good humour and grace from 1980 until his death.

Ordained and inducted Lochgoilhead and Kilmorich, July 1st 1959. Commissioned into RACHD 1962 for Army Cadet Force. Translated Glasgow Pollokshields Kenmure 1965. elected Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts, 1972. Retired to Paisley.
